On special dates listed in this flyer vendors will be selling crafts, antiques and collectibles, seasonal produce, baked goods, rummage and flea market items at an outdoor market in the Coloma Village Park, 232 S Front St (aka-CTY CH), Coloma, WI 54930.

Booths and tables will be set up in a tree shaded area immediately adjacent to the historic Spalding General Store Museum.

Registration for each vendor is \$10 30 days in advance of the market dates and \$15 less than 30 days of the market date if space is available. There is ample parking, restroom facilities, and a fun playground for the kids all nearby.

Some sites are shaded, parking is ample, restroom facilities handy, and there is a fun playground.

Craft & Flea Market will be held **rain or shine**, from 8 am to 3 pm. Bring your own booths, or tables and chairs. Set up in pre-assigned, pre-marked, 10x12 area immediately adjacent to the historic Spalding General Store Museum and vendors are asked to clean up and take home personal belongings after the sale. **Aug 3 is Kids Day at the Market.** Kids are invited to order to sell their specialty. It is their chance to raise money for a cause, a trip or whatever they want. Special events at museums on all flea market dates.

Market spaces are 10x12. Each space reserved 30 days, or more, before market day is \$10.00. Each space reserved less than 30 days before market day is \$15.00. Any preregistered vendor who has not checked in at the Registration Table by 7:30 am, on market day, call #715-570-2009, will give up their advance site and it will be reassigned. Vendors pay \$15 for an available site on market day.
